VENDOR A -- Donation lots from estate of Ralph Badagliacca, all proceeds to PISG!

LOT 1: Huge assortment of probably close to 2,000 worldwide (no U.S.) commercial covers from the 1920s to 1980s. Many interesting items from collectors in many exotic locations; interesting stamps, cancels, who knows what treasures may be found? Very large box full of fun for many evenings! (No Pitcairn!)

LOT 2: Large assortment of Pitcairn MNH stamp sets, mostly 1980s on, some duplication to be expected, all in glassines with Scott's catalogue number and 2024 retail value on each set. Total retail: \$2,339.85.

LOT 3: Same type of assortment as Lot 2, but all used stamp sets with duplication. All in glassines marked with Scott's catalogue number and 2024 retail value. Total retail value: \$967.85.

LOT 4: A substantial collection of better worldwide sets, each in glassines with Scott's catalogue numbers and retail value. Many better such as Bahamas #159-173 MNH (\$86.20), Egypt #J47-53 MNH (\$36.00), Grenada #171-183 MNH (\$51.25), Montserrat #231-243 MNH (\$28.50), Micronesia #5-20 MNH (\$18.10), Jamaica #595-598 MNH (\$7.75), Bermuda #255-265 MNH (\$15.65), St. Vincent #186-196 MNH (\$39.00). Total 2024 Scott's catalogue retail is \$1,032.45.

LOT 5: The Liernie collection of postal history described in the article on page 4. This is a large collection of postal history AND letters from islanders to Dan Liernie in New Jersey during a lengthy period from the 1950s. There are 50 or more period covers, many with cachets, and many more letters from John Christian, Floyd McCoy and other islanders, including school children who refer to "Uncle Dan" throughout because of the many gifts he sent them from the U.S. Very interesting for research purposes or exhibit, and well worth your investment!

LOT 6: A large assortment of Pitcairn cacheted FDCs with duplication. Mainly 1980s-1990s era, unaddressed. Excellent for swapping or selling! The 2024 Scott's retail for the stamps (not FDCs!) is \$2,852.80. Be generous!

LOT 7: Similar to Lot 6, huge assortment of FDCs (NOT same as Lot 6!). 2024 Scott's is \$1,107.20.

LOT 8: Assortment of early UNITED NATIONS (to 1980s?) with many blocks of 10 plus 30 plus pieces of unused postal stationery. Includes Geneva and Vienna issues, everything MNH! Total 2024 Scott's retail is \$513.55 plus. All sets are in glassines marked with Scott's catalogue numbers and values.

LOT 9: Beautiful and clean KaBe Pitcairn album with slipcover (both brown) and stamps to 1997. Many MNH sets, all in glassines paper clipped to the page they go on. Total 2024 Scott's catalogue is \$655.65. Nice album!

LOT 10: Three inch binder CRAMMED with over 150 worldwide covers, early 1900s to about 1960s (?), FDC and special events, commercial covers. A gold mine from exotic places such as Solomon Islands, Christmas Island, Cook Islands, Cocos (Keeling) Islands, Fiji, Gilbert & Ellice Islands, MANY more. Great fun!

LOT 11: Selection of 100+ U.S. FDCs and special event covers from 1930s to 1970s (?).

LOT 12: Probably 75 or more worldwide FDCs, modern, some signed by designer, small islands, etc.

LOT 13: Commercial Czechoslovakia covers (about 75) from 1920s era, some cacheted.

LOT 14: About 50 or more older worldwide commercial covers, 1920s on, exotic locations such as Australian Antarctic Territory, old Germany, Falkland Islands, Norway, India, Australia, U.K., Denmark.

LOT 15: Assortment of mainly different Pitcairn FDCs, special event covers from 1980s era, 40 plus.

LOT 16: Four exotic covers with Pitcairn and French Polynesia stamps, cachet, handwritten, "This cover was landed at all island calls in the Pitcairns, Tuamotus and Marquesas during the Rapa Nu I and II cruises." Signed by the captain and dated April 28, 1995. All addressed to Ralph Badagliacca in New York state.

LOT 17: Fifteen maximum cards with Scott's #249-252, paintings set (card is enlargement of scene on \$2 stamp). The Scott's catalogue value for the sets is \$45.00. Great for trading!?
